Enrollment for the 2011-2012 School Year

Christine Duncan's Heritage Academy will offer grades Kindergarten through 8th for the 2011-2012 academic year. A lottery to determine admission for the 2011-2012 school year will be held on **April 4, 2011 at 5:30 p.m. at the school**. The lottery drawing is open to the public. All available positions will be offered at that time. Upon completion of the Lottery, waitlists will be established for each grade.

Applications to the Lottery will be accepted from March 21st, 2011 to March 31st, 2011 and perspective students will be enrolled in the lottery at that time, you may download an [enrollment packet](#) from this website. **The deadline for submitting applications is March 31, 2011.** Once the Lottery is completed, the remaining students' applications will continue to be pulled to establish the waiting lists for all grades. Notification of an available space is made to the next student on the waiting list as soon as an opening occurs. The waitlist will remain in effect for 2011-2012 school year, but will not carry over to the subsequent years.

FAQ

What grades will CDHA offer in the 2011-2012 school year?

CDHA will offer grades kindergarten through eighth grade in the 2011-2012 school year. Each class will have approximately 20 students, and only one class will be offered at each grade.

How does the CDHA enrollment process work?

We will have a registration period annually for the next school year only. The open registration period for subsequent school year will be held in early spring—periodically check our website for specific dates. Applications may be picked up and submitted during this time period. The number of available spaces will be determined by subtracting the number of continuing students and their incoming siblings, who are given preference, from the total number of spaces for each grade level. If the number of applicants is less than or equal to available spaces for each grade, these students will be notified that they have been admitted to CDHA for the upcoming year. If the number of applicants exceeds available spaces for a given grade, a lottery process will be used to fill available spaces for that grade.

Is it possible to enroll a child in a New Mexico public school who is younger than 5 years of age?

No, state law requires that children be 5 years of age as of September 1st to enroll in a New Mexico public school. Your child, regardless of his/her ability, will not be able to start kindergarten unless the minimum age requirement is met.
